

#### Other takeaways

- CCM 2019 social media campaign saw MORE:
  - Organic exposure
  - New followers
  - Social media engagements (more traction for posts, more support for sponsors, more response to actionable items, more click throughs)
- Best overall post: What is a CDP?
- CDP community used the logo more than any other CCM in their social media
- All this with almost an entirely volunteer effort and less than 15K budget.

# Because... Career Development Matters!

- We are largely an **invisible** public service:
  - The public doesn't know where to find us
  - The public doesn't know what we do
- It's <u>a vital service</u> that makes a difference to individuals, communities, employers and economies
- We are vulnerable to policy whims

#### We need to be more visible!



#### WIIFM

Exposure of the profession through something like Canada Career Month means that:

- The public is aware of and sees the <u>value</u> of career development services and career education.
  - MEANING: they <u>VALUE</u> what we do
- Greater client clarity of expectations around the services we offer
  - MEANING: They come with realistic expectations
- The public knows where to go for service
  - MEANING: They can find us
- Governments see the importance of what we do especially in economic downturns
  - MEANING: They might not target us in funding cuts
- Employers see us as an ally
  - MÉANING: They come to us with their needs and open their doors to our clients



- INCREASE THE SECTOR'S INVOLVEMENT NATIONALLY
- SECURE FUNDING BY MAY 2020
- ONE BIG NATIONAL EVENT: NOVEMBER 18TH
- FOCUS ON CREATING BILLINGUAL, AND EVERGREEN CONTENT
- INCREASE PRESENCE ON LINKEDIN

- INCREASE THE CD SECTOR'S INVOLVEMENT
  - Clearly define how CDPs can participate early
  - Build sustained relationships with the sector
  - Leverage Thought Leaders

- SECURE FUNDING BY MAY 2020
  - Engage a Sponsorship expert
  - Look to past sponsors, and high 2019 corporate, education, and governmental engagers

# GOALS FOR 2020 If our sponsorship efforts prevail...

- ONE BIG NATIONAL EVENT: NOVEMBER 18TH
  - A standardized Career Month event structure
    - Unifying, simple to implement, and accessible
  - Minimum 14 events across Canada
    - One per province/territory, and one in Ottawa for federal.

- FOCUS ON CREATING BILLINGUAL, AND EVERGREEN CONTENT
  - Dedicated funding for translation (En > Fr <u>and</u> Fr > En)
  - Key learning from 2019, we don't have to start anew each year

- INCREASE PRESENCE ON LINKEDIN
  - It's the social media platform where most of us live and it's the platform that folks mainly use for career development activities.
