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
- partnership between University of Alberta's

- paid, interdisciplinary internships for current U of A graduate students



GSIP: DOLLARS & TALENT







The internship program is funded by a Government of Alberta Grant.

The UAlberta model is based on a wage subsidy.

We pay half the minimum hourly rate of \$25.00.

Goals of the GSIP for students

- strengthen transferable skills
- gain experience in professional activities
- gain confidence in their skills, abilities, and career path
- develop connections
- explore career options



Goals of GSIP for employers

- see the value of a graduate degree
- support the professional development of the incoming workforce
- address short-term staffing needs
- develop connections



Student eligibility

- registered U of A student in Masters or PhD program
- students may accept only one full 640 hour GSIP internship during their graduate degree
- international students must comply with Immigration
 Canada regulations



Employer requirements

- create a work experience appropriate for a graduate student
- pay the student \$25/ hour (minimum)
- provide a supervisor to support the student
- provide feedback



GSIP placements

- part-time & full-time
- flexible start/ end dates
- up to 640 hours
- possibility of extension beyond the GSIP funding



What worked well?

- wage-subsidy
- partnerships and collaboration

Four years later

- over 450 graduate students have participated
- many of the GSIP internships have lead to full-time employment
- over 150 employers, many returning to hire more
- 100% of GSIP employers surveyed said they would participate again
